

Proposed Form


Design Statement

The existing site is occupied by 3 blocks of duplex flats. The blocks are set back from the street down a short bank and are obscured by planting and fencing.

The proposed form steps the façade with cantilevered balconies that breaks up the bulk of the building.

The massing of the building is to be further mitigated / enhanced through the materials strategy.



Ground Floor Plan















Breezeway Plan

The breezeway features modular triangular screens that step in and out, offering a glazed face in the SW direction and an expanded mesh in the SE direction promoting airflow.

Balustrades are 1100 AFFL with sloping rails for safety, and stainless-steel fall netting is installed in light wells.

This design balances natural light and views while ensuring weather protection.
