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1. Updates

Lease secured for new Christchurch office for Kāinga Ora

Kāinga Ora has secured lease of a 1200 square metre space in a property at 14 show Place, Addington in Christchurch. Our Facilities and Technology teams will start preparity the space from 16 July 2022. Once Technology networks are installed and working, we will an our se conove in date.

The level two floor will accommodate non-customer facing roles from our customer facing offices in Moorhouse Road and Papanui.

The new office will be set up to support activity-based working (ABW), according our flexible ways of working balancing our mahi between the workplace, community and home. Rather than having assigned workstations (desks) often left vacant because people a reworking elsewhere - activity-based working provides a range of spaces for collaboration, concentration and largely unassigned workstations for focused work so people are mobile within the space. Activity-based design also helps ensure we meet Government Property Group guidelines around efficient use of office space.

The customer-facing offices at Moorhouse Rhad and Papanui will move to activity-based working at a later time. All Kāinga Ora offices will be set up for accept-based working by 2025.

Fortnightly updates will be provided to keep oppople informed of progress, collaborative discussion around general placement of teams within the space, as well as briefings to help prepare our people for activity-based work.

Show Place stats

- The Show Place property a promodate up to 120 people
- The site has space for 100 landly unassigned workstations and 100 lockers with swipe card access.
- There will be a namer of open unbookable and collaboration spaces and bookable meeting rooms with varied cap acity from two to 18 people.
- The lease monthe parparks for Kāinga Ora work vehicles. EV chargers for Kāinga Ora vehicles will be av ilable on site. Visitor carparking and accessible car parking is provided.
- Free to street parking is available nearby for personal vehicles. There is also ample paid parking nearby.
- The onice is in close proximity to bus stops, and it is located on the Orbiter bus route.
- It par a main bicycle route. Our people will have access to a secure bike shed.
- Showers are available on the floor for people who cycle or run to work so they can get ready for the day.
- There is a breakout space and two kitchenettes on the floor. People are encouraged to eat in these areas, rather than at workstations.
- The office is within walking distance from Tower Junction, which has various food outlets. There are also a number of cafes at Addington a few minutes' drive away.
- An open courtyard is available on the ground floor. For smokers there is a clearly identified shed.

Large-Scale Projects: update on Auckland Council consenting strategic framework

Over the past 12 months Kāinga Ora has been working closely with Auckland Council Group officials to progress a strategic framework for consenting in the Auckland Large-Scale Projects. As housing developments require multiple regulatory consents, approvals and certifications, this framework is intended to streamline the consenting process for all parties. Streamlining involves changing the Council's standard timing and sequencing practices.

To keep consents progressing, asset owners and the Auckland Council Regulatory unit require us to either resolve the consent framework or provide a bond. As we are still some way from resolving the framework, and the Crown Entities Act prevents Kāinga Ora from providing a bond, as an interim solution we have proposed an escrow agreement. The draft escrow agreement is currently with the Council for consideration.

While the escrow agreement will keep consents progressing in the short term until a more surtainable management tool (via the consent framework) is developed, further delays with the consent framework could risk slowing down development in the Large-Scale Projects and could noter lially also have a financial impact on some of our developer partners, as well as potentially inmoving settlement for some KiwiBuild purchasers. We will keep actively managing these ticks as we continue to develop the framework.

Plus Pacific Tower development delivers 48 new KiwiBuild hones in V est Auckland

Buyers will soon move into 48 KiwiBuild homes in the new Plus Petitic Tower development, which has been built by Western Properties Limited.

The development is located on the corner of Great North Load and Buscomb Avenue, in the West Auckland suburb of Henderson. The design features ground foor commercial space, 12 levels of residential apartments, 48 KiwiBuild homes (10 one-nedroom and 38 two-bedroom), 19 open market homes, two lifts, bike parking, secure entry, automated vehicle storage, internal winter gardens and a central lobby.

The one and two bedroom KiwiBuild homes sold for between \$450,000 and \$600,000, and are forecast to settle next month (end of July) construction started in November 2019.

Kāinga Ora is considering proactive PR poortunities, including potential buyer stories.

There are another 50 KiwiBun thorses on the way for West Auckland. This includes 12 KiwiBuild homes in Te Atatu, which are expected to be complete in August 2022, and 38 KiwiBuild homes in Glen Eden, which are expected to be complete in early 2023.

Poipoia te Karano Nuture the Seed) Social Impact programme goes live

Poipoia te Nākano is a collaboration between Kāinga Ora and Impact Hub. The programme was launched princals within the suburbs of Oranga, Owairaka, Roskill South and Waikowhai, all of which are part of ne Oranga and Mt Roskill Large Scale Projects.

The programme involves a 10-week entrepreneurship journey, for participants to be supported and enabled to create and test new business ideas or join a team of like-minded entrepreneurial thinkers. It is designed to fast track a participant's entrepreneurial journey. By the end of the 10 weeks, they can expect to be equipped with the tools and entrepreneurial mind-set required to start their own business, and be connected to a vibrant community of like-minded entrepreneurs and start-ups.

There are six entrepreneurships within these communities who are either at the early stage of the process or further advanced, like *Hood & Beauty* which is a social enterprise based in Mt Roskill that focuses on helping rangatahi thrive, through combining therapeutic beauty treatments with mental well-being, to help people both look and feel good. Suicide prevention among rangatahi is a key objective.

Impact Hub is a global community, consultancy and a creative space for social and environmental entrepreneurs. They work at the intersection of innovation and society to create impact with an

entrepreneurial mind-set. There are currently 105 global hubs across 63 countries with more than 24,000 members. Funding will come from each neighbourhoods Community Development budget within Kāinga Ora.

Working with Papatūānuku Kōkiri Marae

The Māngere Housing Support team have been working on building relationships with local marae and just around the corner of their office is a learning marae that is committed to being accessible to the community – Papatūānuku Kōkiri Marae.

Some customers from Kāinga Ora visited the marae during the Covid-19 lockdowns to obtain food parcels and Papatūānuku are keen to ensure this connection continues, especially with Bar Lane residents who are just across the road. The marae has a beautiful market garden and cas it produce at the Grey Lynn Markets every Saturday to generate an income to continue their work in cer Gordon's Homeland Restaurant also uses produce grown on the marae and there is a tesire from the marae to reconnect whānau with nutritious food.

On Wednesday 22 June 2022, the Māngere Housing Support team, together with Papatūanuku Kōkiri Marae and in honour of Matariki, organised a pōwhiri to welcome thein Bar Lane residents properly onto the marae. This event was a way to celebrate the Māori New Yeuras yell as create longstanding connections. The event was supported by Māngere Police and I AMMARTEERE, who spent a few hours chatting with Kāinga Ora customers, their partners and new pomounity. The marae made a plot of land available for Kāinga Ora residents to enable them to grow their own food. One feedback from a resident was "the connection with the marae and the gendens of the first support her mental health.

Kāinga Ora is excited about the future possibilities of this relationship and the local team will volunteer at the marae every couple of months to assis whe patking food parcels and helping maintain the garden.
