

### 1. Updates


### **Mangere Stormwater Street Chats**

On 19 and 26 August 2023, Kāinga Ora collaborated with local community group I AM Mangere on the Mangere 'Street Chats'.

Street Chats provide an opportunity for the Mangere community to connect with Kāinga Ora, Auckland Council's Tāmaki Makaurau recovery office, Healthy Waters and Auck and Emergency Management, around the future of stormwater management in the face of flooding. The events, involving over 60 residents, were delivered in three events in the areas most impacted by flooding - Mangere East, Mangere West and Mangere Central.

At each event our partners shared the services available, including emergency response for the elderly. The role of Kāinga Ora varied depending on the questions that surfaced, with each event illustrating different concerns. These ranged from technical questions on existing and new builds, management of stormwater and drains, resale of homes, rates, and insurance.

Following this consultation, and the 'Making Sp ce for Water' consultation being undertaken by Auckland Council, Kāinga Ora and Auckland Council will deliver a Mangere-wide community hui, which is likely to be held in late November 2023.

### Public notification of the proposed key features for the potential SDPs

The proposed key features of the Porirua Northern Growth Area and Tauranga Western Corridor will be publicly notified on 31 August 2023, seeking public feedback. The proposed key features are the project area, project objectives and project governance body. Public notification will be from 31 August to 29 September 2023 (20 working days). It will include formal public notices in newspapers, content on the Kāinga Ora website, letters to all landowners within the proposed areas, targeted delivery of brochures and public drop-in sessions in each location.

#### Innovative building sector contract pilot ramps up

The Relational Agreement Pilot is aiming to transform how we engage building material suppliers and builders by creating an agreement based on trust, transparency and partnership and focused on outcomes.

The innovative pilot will see a truly co-designed commercial arrangement with build partners and materials suppliers to deliver synergistic outcomes for the building sector. Prospective local build partners and materials suppliers will gather with the Kāinga Ora team on 30 August 2023 to take part in the first awareness session for the contract pilot.

The Relational Agreement will be co-designed with build partners and mat rials suppliers, and then piloted for the construction of more than 100 public homes in Rotorua delivered through the Housing Delivery System method.

The Pilot will see Kāinga Ora taking a more active role in the supply of building materials, and a change in how we build. Transparency is key, with information on costs, crewing levels and lead times shared openly. The co-designed Relational Agreement will focus less on penalties and more on outcomes promoting partnership.

The awareness session in Rotorua this week follows initial Expression Of Interest processes in July 2023. More than 16 local building companies are expected to attend, with at least three material supply businesses. Kāinga Ora Chief Ex cutive, Andrew McKenzie, Delivery Transformation Group General Manager, Matt Hulett, and Commercial Group General Manager, Caroline McDowall, will present

Final decisions on the build partners and suppliers selected for the pilot will follow the awareness session. Shortlisted partners will then be invited for two five-day planning sessions to co-design the pilot agreement, before pricing is submitted for Kāinga Ora to review. Construction on the first homes under the pilot is aimed to begin in Rotorua before the end of 2023.

#### **First Home Partner Update**

We are already seeing significant increase in volumes in the First Home Partner (FHP) scheme since the policy changes were implemented on 14 August 2023. In the last two weeks the number of applications increased for the week from an average of 68, to an average of 267 – a 390 percent increase in volume and slightly higher than anticipated. The average processing time for applications was up slightly to 3.1 days due to the increased number of applications and temporary staff being brought in to support the increased work load. We continue to exceed our target of processing applications within five working days, and to meet timeframes for processing approvals and responding to queries.

While approvals and settlements have decreased week on week, these often fluctuate and should increase once customers find homes and a loan, which we expect to be faster under the changed policy settings. We are planning for the increase in activity in this area to ensure timeframes continue to be met.

### Teitei Drive, Ohakune project

With the ongoing interest continuing around the Ohakune development, Kāinga Ora now plans to advise the local residents and other interested parties that they are to request public notification of both applications for consent (Ruapehu District Council and Horizons Regional Council).

Kāinga Ora is currently working with Council to ensure s92 of the Resource Management Act 1991 matters are adequately addressed, upon which time a notification date will be advised.

Given the level of interest from the community in this development, we have - in consultation with our development partners – requested that the resource consent application for the subdivision is publicly notified. This would enable the community to formally share their views on the application.

A decision on this will be made in due course by the independent consultants who are assessing the consent application for Ruapehu District Council.

### Our customers and their whanau

- 213 customers have been rehoused to date
- 23 customers have vacated and left their Kāinga Ora property
- 26 customers currently in TAS (in the past week we saw three households exit and no new entries)
- 17 customers are living elsewhere
- 10 households are living in our own Emergency Response Ac ommodation where in the past week we saw two households enter the accommodation

### Central region

- 359 homes in the region have been assessed as having damage from the cyclone with the majority – 341 – considered minor damag
- We are aware of:
  - o Wairoa
    - two white placards
    - one yellow placard
  - o Hawke's Bay
    - seven white pla ards
- We have made 4,053 ou bound welfare calls, and referred 312 customer to other agencies for support.
- There were 28 customers that were evacuated, but none required permanent rehousing.
