




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1. Updates

Kāinga Ora lead on play and community connection in Bromley

Christchurch Kāinga Ora customers and their neighbours recently came together, alongside the Fire Service, Sport Canterbury, and the Community Police team - to celebrate play Bromley.

Known as Play Streets, the project saw Pateke Place temporarily closed so the community could use the street for play. The Play Streets concept was developed to encourage physical, social, and mental wellbeing for children and to support friendly, healthy neighbourh ods by connecting communities and building positive relationships.

Around 60 people attended, including children, parents and eighb urs. The children brought bikes, scooters and games, while Kāinga Ora and Sport Canterbury provided play equipment, including jumbo snakes and ladders, and tug of war ropes.

The Fire Service also educated the community about fire prevention in a fun and engaging way, with interactive equipment that simulated a house fire and the best ways to respond. The fire engine and the opportunity to interact with all the equipment n-board was a highlight for the children. Community Police manned the BBQ, which was well received by all the tamariki after hours of play.

Tihitihi Pa Wairoa

An agreement is due to be confirmed for Kāinga Ora to purchase 30 homes in Wairoa. Twenty will be used for public housing and the other 10 for transitional housing. These will be the first new Kāinga Ora homes for Wairoa in many years. The homes are being built by Whakamanamana Limited who are partnering with Enabled, a local charitable trust. Enabled will be providing wrap around support to the customers in the Transitional Housing (10 homes). There will also be seven market homes built on the site.

The two-hectare subdivision, at 150 Black Street, will be known as Tihitihi Pā, as a tribute to the site's history as part of the larger Te Rauwa forest recognising the 'rustle' of people who worked in the forest when harvesting kiekie fruit.

The development will be rolled out in three stages, and will include a community park with playground and barbecue area, maara kai and an Enabled office on site. The onsite office will accommodate housing teams from Enabled Social Housing, Enabled Toitu He Kainga – Wairoa Community Housing Hub, Kāinga Ora, Te Whatu Ora – Te Matau a Maui Child Healthy Homes.

An event to bless the work involved in the building of these homes will be held on 14 February at 10.00 am.

Early Engagement on over 100 proposed new homes for New Plymouth

Early engagement on the proposed redevelopment plans of our properties across New Plymouth starts on Tuesday, 21 February. Three city-wide drop in sessions will be held as well as an online session. Our early plans suggest we could deliver more than 00 new homes across New Plymouth, focusing initially on the suburbs of Westown, Frankleigh Park, Brooklands, Vogeltown and Spotswood.

The drop in sessions will provide an opportunity for us to share some early information and plans, as well as hear thoughts and ideas around how we can best support the community to be thriving, sustainable and inclusive.

Demolition of Karamu Tower Blocks

Two tower blocks in Karamu Road Hastings were deemed earthquake prone early in 2022. Kāinga Ora customers were informed and rehousing of customers living in the building began. New homes have now been found for all the Kāinga Ora customers, and customers in the adjoining 13 single level homes on Pattison S reet are also now being rehoused, as part of wider redevelopment plans.

Deconstruction of the uildings has started and scaffolding has been erected with the buildings being wrapped to ensure the safe removal of asbestos. Demolition will be scheduled in conjunction with adjoining schools to minimise any disruption. We will be talking to the community about early plans for redevelopment the outpout 2023.

For similar towe blocks in Carnell Street, Napier, customers are also being rehoused with deconstruction of the buildings likely to start this year.
