




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1. Updates

Work started on former Boulevard Motel, Rotorua

This week work started on upgrading the former Boulevard Motel on Fenton Street in Rotorua, which will provide over 80 people including families, with transitional housing. Settlement on the purchase and immediate commencement of work at the former motel took place last week at Covid-19 alert level 3.

Safety and security fencing has been installed, and local contractors have commenced interior work, as well as removal of overgrown vegetation at the rear of the site. The motel sign will be removed next week.

A staged approach to delivering the units is planned, and there is expected to be an initial delay in this due to the impact of alert level requirements on the settlement date, materials supply chain, and from the lead contractor being Auckland based. The first units are now expected to be available in late October.

The units will be managed by experienced local provider of housing and support services, Wera Aotearoa Charitable Trust, with 24/7 onsite support available

The 0.66-hectare site was also purchased for its redevelopment potential for mixed housing further down the track, and is well located close to transport, services and the city centre.

Five Systems Research and Development Programme

The Five Systems Research and Development Programme has been shortlisted for one of 12 places at the United Nations Conference of the Parties (COP26) summit in Glasgow, UK, in November 2021. This represents an opportunity to internationally showcase some of the proactive work that Aotearoa New Zealand is doing to mitigate climate change. We were notified of the shortlisting on 1 September and have been asked to make a submission for the final selection process by 9 September. The submission will include a written document, video content and digital material. If successful, final submission will be 27 September.

Consentium wins innovation award

Kāinga Ora Building Consent Authority (BCA) Consentium won the Innovator of the Year Award at the Building Officials Institute of New Zealand (BOINZ) Excellence Awards. The team is also a finalist for two further awards in the RICS Awards 2021 (Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors). Winners for these awards will be announced in early September.

Consentium has been in operation since March 2021 and provides consenting services exclusively to Kāinga Ora for public housing of up to four levels. As New Zealand's first nationally accredited and registered non-Territorial Authority BCA, Consentium was innovative in its very establishment.

A BCA which was not managed by a Territorial Authority had not been considered in the Building Act (2004) and Building (Accreditation of Building Consent Authorities) Regulations 2006. Consentium's establishment, therefore, required consideration and, at times, collaboration. Likewise, audit programmes and assessment methods needed to be updated by the regulator MBIE and assessor International Accreditation New Zealand (IANZ) to meet the new requirements.

Consentium also takes an innovative and proactive approach to its day-to-day operations and this is reflected in the way it addresses newer technologies, such as Off-site Manufacturing (OSM). The team is developing a Memorandum of Understanding to provide a streamlined consenting pathway for homes built using OSM methods. They expect to share the learnings and processes with their counterparts in other BCAs in due course.

Sandringham Drop in Session

Prior to COVID-19 Level Four, on 5 August 2021 Kainga Ora held a drop in session to share information on plans to build new, warm and dry homes in Sandringham. These homes will see replacement of existing older Kainga Ora homes and delivery of different typologies of housing to meet demand.

The community event was held in the evening at the Sandringham Community Centre, with Kāinga Ora having subject matter experts attending to answer the different questions that arose. In total, 75 people attended the event, from Kāinga Ora customers, neighbours, community groups and community members.

It was a lively engagement, with some positive responses and support that was summed up in an email post event. The housing designs were positively received by the community and they welcomed more events in the future.
