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1. Updates

Proposed Alfriston Village Plan Change - Joint development update

Kāinga Ora has entered into a Development Cooperation Agreement with Wirelemere Holdings Ltd to progress a proposal to jointly develop approximately 70 ha in Alfriston, South Au kland, for urban purposes.

Windermere's portion of the land is zoned rural and the Kāinga Gra land's zoned future urban. Any urban development is dependent on a notified plan change to the ruck and Unitary Plan, changing the rural zoned land (including the rural/urban boundary) and future arban zoned land to an urban development zone.

The site's proximity to existing schools, employment areas public ansport networks, and a range of existing community amenities makes it an extremely well-connected greenfields opportunity, which will enable more housing without extensive infrastructural investment or growth in transport-related carbon emissions.

The Development Agreement includes a commoment to ensuring that a range of housing opportunities are provided for. Both parties to be agree nent will ramp up stakeholder engagement in the next few months, beginning with brief how to be relevant Local Boards and schools in mid-August.

Sustainability, ecology, and stormwater management will be at the heart of the proposed development, with special attention paid to preserving and enhancing the quality of waterways and native flora and fauna on the site. Mana whenua engagement commenced earlier in the year.

Reconnecting with Auckland Community Housing Provider Network

On the 8 August 2022 the Tāmaki Tai Tokerau team presented to the Auckland Community Housing Provider Network (CCHPN). Community Housing Aotearoa (CHA) representatives opened the session and Ministry of Housing and Urban Development representatives were also in attendance. We regularly tork with providers on the ground but last formally met and presented to ACHPN in 2021. This recent meeting was a good opportunity to reconnect after the interruptions imposed by COVID-19.

The initial request for this session was to provide information on our Auckland development pipeline. We additionally provided insights into some of our larger multi-storey developments, our recent regional planning work and the Auckland Community Housing portfolio. From a national perspective, updates were provided on our off-site manufacture activity and Project Velocity.

There have been follow-up requests from the ACHPN for more detail on suburb level development activity across Auckland and opportunities to work together to understand housing demand from specific populations and communities. We look forward to this continued collaboration.

Community mahi for Shirley community in Christchurch:

Members of our Christchurch Housing Support and Engagement Teams recently lent their time and muscle to support a community project in the suburb of Shirley that will be of huge benefit to whānau next winter.

Our teams identified some trees that were being removed for redevelopment and approached the Shirley Village Project Team to see if these could be put to better use. They helped move some very heavy timber "rings" so they can eventually be cut up for firewood next year to assist whānau in need in that community. The trees are expected to produce about 28 cubic metres of firewood, which will be deeply appreciated and valued by the whānau.

The Shirley Village Project brings residents and organisations together to find local solutions to scal issues and this mahi involving our staff was a great example of a community partnership in ection.

The staff thoroughly enjoyed helping out in a community where Kāinga Ora has a significant hamber of homes, and were pleased to know that their recent efforts will help to keep many what warm and dry next winter.

Archaeology in the community

Our people across Kāinga Orahave nabled the Puketāpapa community to understand their local archaeology and history and ensure that it lives on at the heart of their community.

Over the last four years Ka la Beazley from Kāinga Ora's Community Engagement and Partnership team along with Arc laes agist Dr Hans Dieter-Bader have met with May Road Primary School's Mana Whenua Rōpū a diver e group of tamariki who have been keen to learn more about their local history.

The rōpū c nbacked on a series of inspiring history activities, including learning about archaeology, having Puk tāpapa/Pukewiwi Tihi tours (alongside the extended community), storytelling in ancient kuma a pis of the maunga, and visits to two live archaeological sites in the area. Dr Hans (as he is affect onately called by the students) noted that the school has the only recorded archaeological find in Puke Tapap, where a skull and small adzes were found. The rōpū created a diorama of their whenua, a wa and maunga featuring a pah site, in so doing inspiring other schools in the neighbourhood to do the same. The knowledge that has been passed on has brought a new-found sense of pride and sense of belonging in tamariki, which has been contagious. Teachers, particularly those who live locally or who come from the area, have also taken a keen interest in learning about the area and connecting to their whenua.

One of the visits to the school has resulted in the move to save the shell midden/taonga, which is overlooked by the maunga. Through Karla's work with Principal Advisor Heritage Scott Lomas, and Assistant Development Manager Vikki Cottingham, the school has become kaitiaki of the taonga, with the support of Te Ākitai Waiohua. This journey has also been supported along the way by Te Kurutao and of course Mana Whenua. The shell midden will be incorporated into the Ministry of Education landscape design of the upgrade at the school.

The Kāinga Ora team are currently working together to coordinate Ngāti Whātua Ōrākei to perform an uplifting karakia, so that Piritahi can transport the taonga to the temporary holding space under a large Pōhutukawa tree at May Road Primary. Once there, the school will welcome the taonga and manuhiri with karakia, kapa haka, whaikorereo and manaakitanga. This is expected to take place later in August, and will see the precious taonga endure.


