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1. Updates



Porirua Development update

On 25 March 2023, Kāinga Ora and our partners Porirua City Council and Ngāti Toa Rangatira will host a blessing and street naming event at Waka Ama Street in the Niger Development. The name Waka Ama has been gifted by Ngāti Toa Rangatira and is steeped in the history and traditions of waka sailing and voyaging; recognising that Waka Ama is not just a sport but also a vehicle for identity, pride and community.

Following the blessing, construction will commence on 18 new warm, dry homes in the Niger Development. The homes will be a mix of one, two, three, four and five-bedroom dwellings, six of which will be accessible.

Specified Development Project Request – Rotorua Lakes Council

Mayor Tania Tapsell of Rotorua Lakes Council, has asked Kāinga Ora to consider using its powers under the Urban Development Act to select Ngongotahā for assessment as a potential Specified Development Project (SDP).

The Council has identified Ngongotahā as a potential growth area and a possible location for housing to address the housing deficit in the district.

We have met with Council officials to understand what geographical area the Council thinks is suited to an SDP, and learn what the Council hopes to achieve in the area. We will work to build a shared understanding of the issues and opportunities an SDP may be able to address, and the roles and responsibilities of councils involved in an SDP.

Officials at Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga – Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) advise that you are scheduled to meet with Mayor Tapsell later this month. To ensure you are fully informed before your meeting, Kāinga Ora staff will update officials at HUD on discussions with Council.

This is just one of the ways the Home Ownership and Community Engagement teams partner to promote Kāinga Ora mahi and support whānau into home ownership.

Lisa was kept busy most of the day with questions and requests for information packs about our home ownership products. Tamariki had a go at the giant Jenga tower at the front of the stall and took away Kāinga Ora branded coloured pencils, lollipops and cookie times biscuits.

There were many local businesses and organisation supporting the event. It was therefore also an excellent opportunity to network with organisations such as the Greater Hornby Residents' Association, 126 on the corner and the Menz Shed.






Mahi Tahi in Ellerslie



New homes for Whangārei

On the morning of 9 March 2023, 17 new homes at Puriri Park, Whangārei were blessed by local kaumātua and representatives from Te Parawhau hapū. Kāinga Ora customers joined the local team, with one customer thanking Kāinga Ora staff for providing her with a home after living in women's refuge for several months.

This development will be formally opened next month when the final stage is delivered.



Interim leadership changes

Delivering our construction programme and implementing the Housing Delivery System (formerly known as Project Velocity) are critical tasks for Kāinga Ora. They require focussed and purposeful action, driven by leaders who have the time and experience required to support teams within a complex environment. Given the volume of work in front of us, the different skillsets and experience required for these tasks going forward, and acknowledging the challenges outlined above, some interim changes to our leadership arrangements are needed.

Construction and Innovation: General Manager Construction and Innovation, Patrick Dougherty will continue to lead and manage the business as usual functions in Construction and Innovation. The delivery of social housing is one of our key priorities and we want to ensure that we continue to deliver with our traditional build programme and partners.

Commercial Group: General Manager Commercial, Caroline McDowall will continue in her current capacity. In addition she will take over the day-to-day development, management and operation of the Housing Delivery System, including all current and future MBUs.

Transformation Projects: The work done on changing our residential construction approach, particularly the challenging of some deeply embedded industry processes at a detailed level, has been truly transformational for Kāinga Ora and the wider construction industry. It has demonstrated the importance of putting time, rigour, and senior leadership into our bottom-up approach to change. There are other areas where we are looking to achieve the same type and level of change - our Asset Management and Maintenance Programmes, and our Land Development Programme. The change programmes have started, with sponsorship from General Manager National Services, Nick Maling and General Manager Urban Development and Delivery, Mark Fraser, and initiation by their respective leadership groups.

Delivery Transformation Group: A Delivery Transformation group is being stood up to support and enable other key business groups at Kāinga Ora to transform their delivery functions. Matt Hulett, who is currently our Project Velocity Lead, has been seconded into the General Manager role to establish and lead the new group. Matt will remain involved in the Housing Delivery System to ensure Caroline is supported, but he will be freed from the operational responsibilities so he and the Delivery Transformation Team can focus on other delivery systems within Kāinga Ora. The first delivery system changes that the Delivery Transformation Team will support are our Asset Management and Maintenance systems, and Land Development system.

There is a reasonable amount of planning and preparation to do and we will keep you informed on key developments. We have also briefed key stakeholders including DPMC, HUD and PSC.


