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1. Updates

Remediation of heritage Waikato star block completed

A slice of Waikato social housing history has been retained with the completic of the refurbished star block in Frances Street, Hamilton.

Built in the late 1960s, the Heritage-B listed building in Frances Street is the cally Kāinga Ora star block in the Waikato. The building has undergone a complex remedia or which retains the heart of the building while making significant improvements to its features.

In consideration of its heritage status, Hamilton City Council requested that a number of architectural features of the building be retained. This included the butterfly of form, balustrading, and window configuration. Kāinga Ora responded to these requests by redectioning the roof form to eliminate problematic junctions, while retaining the overall appearance. Unlike some other star blocks where the balustrading has been removed completely, at Frances Street it was re-created from more durable powder-coated aluminium and installed on the face of the new fire aprons that that adorn the upper levels.

The building has been extensively retrofit a proughout with new insulation to floors, walls and ceilings, high-performance double glazing improvements to the fire safety systems, new ventilation systems, and heat pumps within all units. Furnding, electrical, and communication services have also been totally replaced, resetting the suilding for another 50 years of service.

Other enhancements include 2CT (cameras, access control, and new intercom systems to provide a safe and secure environment in each has also been extensively fenced in a sympathetic manner and additional planting added

New hones at Ranolf Street and Malfoy Road, Rotorua

This week, families move from emergency housing into six new offsite manufactured (OSM) homes at the latest Kāinga Ora development in Rotorua. The previously vacant two-hectare site on the corner of Ranolf Street and Malfroy Road was purchased in 2021, and is being developed for public housing in stages. The first phase comprises 37 three and four-bedroom homes in total. Six are ready now, a further 19 will be completed by the end of the year, and the final 12 homes early next year. There will also be a community room and shared green space for residents. The second phase, on the corner section of the site, is in the planning stage and is expected to include a further 20 multi-storey homes.

The development is an example of Kāinga Ora scaling up its use of OSM build methods to provide more housing for people and whānau in need. The quality, modern three and four-bedroom homes were built offsite in Huntly by Kāinga Ora build partner Builtsmart, one of the largest suppliers of OSM homes in New Zealand. More new OSM homes are coming to Rotorua and the Bay of Plenty soon

thanks to a new Kāinga Ora contract with Rotorua business Exeter Homes. They will build 12 new Kāinga Ora homes offsite in their facility, seven of which are for Rotorua and five for Ōpōtiki. These will be delivered early next year.

Minister Woods and Kāinga Ora officials visited both Exeter Homes and the Ranolf Street homes last Thursday, prompting positive media coverage on One News, STUFF and the Rotorua Daily Post.

Blessing of Freeland Reserve

More than 50 people attended the dawn blessing of Freeland Reserve on Wednesday morning, let by Ngāti Whātua Ōrākei and Ngā Mana Whenua o Tāmaki Makaurau. The blessing also marks be first shovel-ready project to be completed in our large scale projects.

Freeland Reserve has been transformed from underutilised space prone to flooding to significant amenity for the Roskill South neighbourhood. It has brand new stormwater infractive the, walkways to promote safer routes to school and park areas complete with wetlands, boardwalks, viewing decks, more than 7,800 native plants and trees, and a BBQ area.

The reserve has been designed as a gathering place in the heart of the complexity, and is a great example of collaboration between Kāinga Ora, Auckland Council and Hearthy Waters, our civil construction alliance Piritahi, mana whenua, Puketāpapa Local Board, te Whāngai Trust, and many other artists, community groups and rōpū. A community event and original public opening is earmarked for late October 2022.

Nort cote LSP update

In Noncock we have been working in earnest with Shane Brealey and NZ Living on a programme issue that threatened to hold up NZ Living's ability to complete unit titles and settle finished apartments, including KiwiBuild. The risk was unoccupied but finished units coming into the Christmas period. You have been briefed on this previously.

We have successfully completed all outstanding construction and certification processing with title issued by LINZ on 30 August 2022, bringing the project back on programme (the original milestone date was 31 August). We are pleased to have rectified this and avoided the programme and reputational issues that might have arisen if delayed. With our delivery obligations met, NZ Living are able to proceed with their own certification and unit title process.

Weir Lane Spring Clean

On 27 August 2022, staff from the Takapuna Area office and the North-West Auckland Community Engagement and Partnership team, along with residents of Weir Lane, Silverdale, undertook a spring clean-up of inorganic rubbish followed by a barbecue. In addition to bringing the community together, this gave the residents an opportunity to share their thoughts on recent media attention and disruption due to the local focus on the proposed Bonair development.

Residents noted that they are normal people, who have had little opportunity to tell their story, and that they would like to speak to future planning community meetings. They also support further public housing in their community as they know there is a very real need. Further, they noted that the children in the homes attend the local early child education facility across the road and at Silverdale Primary school. Residents have a good relationship with both providers, and find the teachers and school to be very supportive.

The day was a success in both spring-cleaning and connecting with the community.




