1. Updates

Super Saturday

Kāinga Ora was proud to play a part in the Super Saturday vaccination drive. In Te Tai Tokerau, Tenancy Mangers called about 650 customers in Whangarei and Kaitaia in the lead-up to Super Saturday to spread the word about vaccination and check for any additional support, such as mobile vaccination, that would help them get the jab.

In Te Puku Ikaroa, teams connected with their local DHBs and community health providers to support local activities planned for Super Saturday, and as part of our wider work with the vaccination campaign. Our teams were equipped with information on local vaccination initiatives to share with customers during their regular engagements to help raise awareness of support and services available, and understand if there is any other support they may need

In Te Wai Pounamu, Kāinga Ora took part in the best response in the country with 17,037 Cantabrians getting a vaccination on Saturday, 3.5 percent of the eligible population. Working with the Canterbury DHB, we also sent a text to all our Canterbury customers encouraging them to make the most of Super Saturday.

Kāinga Ora Māori Strategy

We are working towards a soft online launch of the Kāinga Ora Māori Strategy on 8 November 2021. This follows the release of the GPS Housing and Maihi Ka Ora. We will provide you a briefing prior to the soft release.

The launch will be focused on thanking Tira members, Iwi leaders, Board members, Māori housing experts, Te tuāpapa-kura-kāinga, Te Puni Kōkiri and Kāinga Ora participants in the development of the strategy. Design and translation of the document is being progressed this month. We are continuing to ensure a strong and visible alignment of the Kāinga Ora Māori Strategy with Maihi Ka Ora. This includes alignment of the Kāinga Ora Strategy with the Kāinga Ora Māori Strategy. Both strategies reflect the 'Waka Hourua' approach adopted by Kāinga Ora embracing the concept of 'mana-o-rite'.

Earth works to begin - Stage One Porirua Housing Development Project

A small blessing ceremony was held by Ngāti Toa Rangatira kaumātua Taku Parai to mark the beginning of major earthworks and infrastructure upgrades for stage one of the Porirua housing development project that will start in the coming weeks.

This work will not only help to future proof the three water networks but also ensure the pipes are resilient for future generations. In parallel, the land will be prepared to form the foundation to build new homes in the area.

Stage one of this development project will see a mix of over 100 homes, ranging from one to five bedroom, replacing 55 state homes. In attendance were representatives from Kāinga Ora, Development Partners Ngāti Toa Rangatirá, Porirua City Council and including Mayor Nita Baker, Te Aranga (Civils group) and local MP Barbara Edmonds.
