The Building Momentum in-person event featuring the Bader Ventura Passive House development will be held on 5 July 2022. Stakeholder engagement to discuss the Porirua Development & Te Aranga alliance

Recently, meetings have been had with both Helmut Modlik, Chief Executive Te Rūnanga o Toa Rangatira, and Wendy Walker, Chief Executive Porirua City Council to investigate ways of developing a closer working relationship on the Porirua Development and the Te Aranga alliance. Both of these organisations have significant interest in the development and want to work alongside Kāinga Ora to ensure that all outcomes are achieved, and that the community are involved throughout the process. Areas of improvement and looking at how we can progress our working relationships are key focuses of all three organisations and these will be discussed at regular catch up meetings between the partners.

Resource consent granted for new Meadowbank development

Resource consent has been granted for a nine home development in Meadowbank, Auckland. It will be the third new Kāinga Ora development to date in this east Auckland suburb.

Plans for the 1,329m² site on Pūroto Street comprises a three storey walk-up containing two and three-bedroom units. The ground floor dwellings will be accessible.

The development of Pūroto Street is long-awaited and will provide much needed smaller family homes, which are in demand in this area. The new homes are located close to the train station and cycle path and will be built on land which has been vacant since 2016.

The business case is now being progressed and delivery is scheduled for late 2023. We will continue to keep the community, neighbours and stakeholders well informed as we progress this development.

Mauri returned and properties blessed at Border Road, Henderson

On 20 June 2022, at sunrise, the Mauri (whenua) was returned to Border Road, Henderson and six new homes were blessed by Mātua Pita Pou, Whaea Te Ara Totoro, and Mātua John Paterson.

The site previously accommodated 18 houses built in the 1970s, which are being replaced with 47 new warm and dry homes. The development comprise a mixture of two, three, four, five and six bedroom homes, including seven fully accessible and 13 partially accessible units.

On 17 June 2022, MP Hon Kelvin Davis and Youth MP Mukai Duder-Hura visited the site and commented on the spacious feel of the interior of the houses, and progress of the development.

Planting Days, Street and Stream Cleans in Mangere and Ōtara

On 9 and 11 June 2022, the Māngere Housing Support and Community Engagement and Partnerships team in Counties Manukau have been supporting the tree planting events along Te Ara Rata Stream and Haranaia Stream, organised by the Te Ara Rata Stream Team and Māngere East Family Services respectively. On 18 June, the Māngere Housing Support team also organised a street clean of Tapuwae Way to help customers to get rid of household and inorganic waste with the aim to beautify and keep waste off their streets and pests away from their homes.

The Ōtara Housing Support team have also been working alongside Ōtara Waterways and Lakes Trust the past couple of weekends to assist with clearing waste off and around Ōtara Creek. There was a focus on pest trapping in backyards and supplying free skip bins for residents along Velvet Crescent on 11 June, while 18 June's activities centred around clearing banks of the creek along Hamill Road.

These events have been a great opportunity to re-engage with the community and work with key stakeholders across Mangere and Ōtara.

To show their gratitude, the Housing Support team hosted a morning tea to say thank you to MSD for their hospitality and will continue to work together for the best outcome for our customers.
