RFP open for lifecycle carbon assessment software

Kāinga Ora released a Request for Proposal (RFP) on 19 January 2022 for technology to enable rapid, whole-of-building, whole-of-life lifecycle carbon assessments and reporting on emissions for our new building projects. Kāinga Ora intends to use the life cycle carbon information collected at the project level to inform decision-making and enable selection of lower carbon solutions during design and construction phases. It will also be used to meet external compliance and standards requirements. Respondents will have until 2 March 2022 to submit their proposals and the outcomes of the process will be known by the end of April 2022. Procurement Update

In line with our Building Momentum plan and the Construction Sector Accord, Kāinga Ora is establishing a number of preferred supplier panels for construction consultancy services. We have identified the following categories as suitable for creating closer working relationships with key construction design partners:

- Engineer to Contract
- Architecture, including urban design, landscape architecture
- Engineering Services including civil, geotechnical, traffic and transport
- Building Engineering Services including structural, mechanical, HVAC, electrical, fire and façade, etc.
- Quantity Surveying

The RFP for Engineer to Contract was released in December 2021 and responses are being assessed now. We expect to communicate the outcome of this to the market over the next month. The RFP for Architects, including Urban Design and Landscape Architects, will be released in late February 2022 through GETS and Tenderlink with a six week response window. The RFP for Building Engineering Services RFP will be released in early March followed by the Engineering Services RFP in early April, both through GETS and Tenderlink with a six week response window.

This is an exciting opportunity for us to partner with construction consultancy services to support the extensive Kainga Ora build programme.

Kāinga Ora raises \$450 million Wellbeing Bond in February towards financing this year's capital expenditure

Kāinga Ora successfully raised \$450 million towards financing warmer dryer homes through issuing additional Wellbeing Bonds to both New Zealand and Offshore investors. Final demand saw 80 percent placed with domestic investors, and 20 percent offshore for the April 2030 maturity. The issue was priced 15 February 2022 at a yield of 3.40 percent, with proceeds settled 24 February 2022.

This is the first syndicated bond issue undertaken since April 2021, with monthly bond tenders having provided regular issuance to the market since December 2020. The bond transaction while executed under a challenging backdrop, attracted new and significant offshore investors into the book build. Kāinga Ora achieved key outcomes such as continuing to add to its longer dated debt maturities, while also increasing liquidity into the 2030 bond line to \$1.1 billion. The issue ensures Kāinga Ora has pre-financed a significant remainder of the current fiscal year's capital expenditure.

A key differentiator for Kāinga Ora Wellbeing Bonds, with investors, is our Sustainability Financing Framework. The framework outlines our approach towards social and environmental outcomes through finance, such as the number of green buildings delivered, and number of Priority A + B tenants housed. Our environmental, social and wellbeing outcomes under the framework are reported in the Sustainability Financing Impact Report.

Kāinga Ora is the only AAA rated Environmental/Social/Governance (ESG) issuer in New Zealand, providing a point of difference for our debt issuance programme. It was great to receive feedback that we had participation in this issue due to direct environmental and social mandates for offshore investors. Indicating investors are increasingly being driven by ESG investment decisions supporting our sustainability and wellbeing bond programme.

The issue reflects the great work across the whole of the Finance and Sustainability teams, and the entire Kāinga Ora organisation itself.

Greening our communities to enhance wellbeing project

The Māngere office, in collaboration with the Urban Planning Group's Urban Ngāhere project 'Greening our communities to enhance wellbeing' is encouraging food growing by our Māngere customers. Last week 70 "tipu tubs" were delivered to residents living in the Bader, McKenzie and Cornwall complexes in Māngere. Each tipu tub has a medley of kale, green chillies, silver beet, lettuce, coriander and basil. There were packets of seedlings provided with each tub so that once customers harvest their fresh crop of vegetables and herbs, they can replant. The tipu tubs were sourced from Ngāti Whātua Ōrākei's horticultural programme.
