1. Updates

New housing in Blenheim

Construction of the first stage of a 15-home development in Blenheim that will be sed for transitional housing is expected to be completed next month.

Kāinga Ora is building the two-bedroom homes in South Street which will be managed by Gateway Housing Trust and will help to meet the demand for transitional hou ing in Blenheim.

The first stage is expected to be completed by end of June 2023 and some people will move in after this date. The second stage is expected to be completed by end of September 2023.

Gateway Housing Trust is a Non-Government Organisation (NGO) that delivers a broad range of social services across the upper South Island and has extensive experience managing transitional housing.

Last week, we informed neighbours and other stakeholders that construction of the first stage of the development is almost complete, and that the homes will be managed by Gateway Housing Trust.

Mana whenua gift name for Porirua Development

Mana whenua Ngāti Toa Rangatira has gifted a name for the Porirua Development: Te Rā Nui.

Ngāti Toa Rangat ra is a partner in the Porirua Development alongside Kāinga Ora and Porirua City Council, and Te Rā Nui reflects our shared purpose in eastern Porirua. It speaks of the 'rising sun of a great new day' that brings new light, new energy and a greater sense of wellbeing to Porirua's land and people.

A new day holds the hope and aspiration of the community. Many have journeyed here from across the waters, in search of a better life for themselves and their whānau. Our great new day now sees the community setting off together on a new journey towards a brighter future.

Te Rā Nui is a powerful expression of the mana of this area, and of the important work being undertaken for, and with, the people who call Porirua home, today and tomorrow.

The new name will be shared at the upcoming series of community events, Hui tahi tātou o Porirua, which starts on Friday, 26 May 2023.

Employee home ownership pilot with Fulton Hogan (Waikato)

Kāinga Ora has partnered with Fulton Hogan and Sorted to launch a home ownership education pilot for Fulton Hogan employees in the Waikato. The pilot is centred on a series of events and workshops, designed to build knowledge of the path to home ownership and the support available (via the Kāinga Ora home ownership products).

Interested Fulton Hogan employees and their whānau can attend an online home ownership programme, hosted by Kāinga Ora and Sorted. The first of eight weekly workshops was held on 2 May 2023, and will continue through to July 2023.

Earlier in April 2023, Fulton Hogan also hosted an in-person home ownership seminar for employees, with representation from Kainga Ora and other partners.

Approximately 33 percent of Fulton Hogan's workforce in the Waikato identify as Māori Kāinga Ora is working to support Māori whānau and individuals to achieve their home ownersh p aspirations, therefore the pilot with Fulton Hogan was a great opportunity for both organisations to work together and enable great outcomes.

Piloting an approach in the Waikato will also inform further education opportunities in other housing growth regions.



Launch of Ngaa Hau o Maangere Planting Guidelines

On 22 May 2023, Kāinga Ora helped launch the Ngaa Hau o Maangere Planting Guidelines; a collaboration between mana whenua, Mangere East Family Services, Uru Whakaaro and Kāinga Ora. Around 60 representatives from the community and contributing organisations came together for kōrero and kai to celebrate the guide, which is now publicly available on the Kāinga Ora website.

The guide sets down values and principles, as expressed by mana whenua, that step the reader through a decision making process for selecting the right tree for the right place. It aims to be an accessible resource, used by all those working to protect, restore and regenerate ngahere across the many landscapes of Ngaa Hau o Maangere.

The Ngaa Hau o Maangere Planting Guidelines forms part of the Mangere Ngahere Demonstration Project, which aims to increase canopy cover and support the local board's Ngahere Action Plan. The Demonstration Project is also helping Kāinga Ora develop frameworks, policies, ways of working and tools for how we can contribute to protecting and enhancing ngahere on all Kāinga O a properties and the communities that we work in.





7. Impacts of weather events

- There are now **681** properties across the Auckland region affected.
- 673 inspections have been completed, two are in progress and six not applicable due to pending redevelopment plans
- Linked to the **681** impacted properties, **311** customers will be required to either move or receive an offer to move.
 - o To date, **165** customers have started new tenancies

Central region

- 359 homes in the region have been assessed as having damage from the cyclone with the majority 341 considered minor damage.
- We are aware of:
 - o Wairoa
 - two white placards
 - one yellow placard
 - Hawke's Bay
 - seven white placards
- We have made 4,053 outbound welfare calls, and referred 312 customer to other agencies for support.
- There were 28 customers that were evacuated but n ne required permanent rehousing.
