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1. Updates

Kāinga Ora delivers its biggest development of FY22

Kāinga Ora has completed our 102-unit development in St Georges Road, Avondale, Auckland. It is our biggest delivery of FY2022 and our largest to date in Avondale. These dwellings have been delivered across eight buildings ranging in typology from 2-storey terraces, 3-storey walk-ups and 5-and 6-storey apartment blocks with lifts. The development also includes on-site offices, a small private park for residents, along with a community room.

Two build partners were involved in the construction: Kalmar delivered the apartment blocks, and Miles Construction completed the walk-ups and terraces. Notably, this was the first Kāinga Ora site to achieve accredited status with the mental health and suicide prevention programme, MATES in Construction, a testament to our contractors. The site works also incorporated the construction of an underpass connecting the New Lynn to Avondale Shared Path, which was a collaborative effort between Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency, Auckland Transport, Kāinga Ora and Kalmar.

St Georges Road is initially intended for transitional housing, and these one, two and three-bedroom homes are in the process of being furnished. Families will begin moving in at the end of this month.

Request for Information released for 139 Greys Ave Digital Platform

Kāinga Ora has released a Request for Information via GETS that seeks to gain an understanding of potential digital platform options that are available to assist with building a thriving and connected community at our 139 Greys Ave site in Auckland.

As identified by participating in the GovTech Accelerator Programme, Kāinga Ora is working to create a digital platform that will incentivise community engagement by using time-banking and virtual token currency to activate communal spaces, encourage participation, and provide an opportunity for the whole community to contribute to creating a more connected and inclusive community. The virtual

tokens will be able to be exchanged for items such as food and drink from local businesses. Kāinga Ora has already trialled this system with the Lifewise Merge Café, where tokens have been exchanged for coffee.

The Request for Information on GETS will identify the scalability of the platforms and the cost to Kāinga Ora of each option. This information will be used to help inform the procurement process for the platform to be in place at 139 Greys Ave once the building is occupied.

Large Scale Projects business case workshops with Auckland Council Group

Development of the three Programme Business Cases for the Auckland Large-Scale Projects (LSP) is well advanced. Cabinet approval of these business cases is required to secure the release of funding that has been allocated to the Kāinga Ora LSPs through the Housing Acceleration Fund (up to \$2.3 billion, including Porirua).

Urban Development and Delivery (UDD) will conduct four workshops over the next couple of weeks, meeting with Auckland Council's Healthy Waters and Parks and Community Facilities' units, as well as Watercare, Auckland Transport and Waka Kotahi. UDD representatives will take our Auckland infrastructure partners through the approach to preparing the draft Kāinga Ora programme business cases for the Mangere, Roskill and Oranga, and Tamaki LSPS, including non-financial benefits and next steps.

This week Kāinga Ora provided you with an update on the business case process and next steps, ahead of you discussing the Large-Scale Projects with Cabinet in mid-December. Kāinga Ora can discuss this with you further at the Officials' meeting on Monday 29 November 2021.

These briefings are currently taking place, with the first one occurring last week.

Approach to renewals

In our October briefing note (BN 21 026) we committed to discussing our proposed approach to renewing our portfolio with you in late 2021. Our current approaches to renewing state homes that require significant capital investment to meet the needs of our customers include retrofit, redevelopment and replacement.

Subsequent to our briefing note there have been a number of key changes that we now need to consider to determine if they have an impact on our proposed approach, namely:

- the recent announcements on the Resource Management (Enabling Housing Supply and Other Matters) Amendment Bill i.e. assessing the extent to which sites that may have previously been identified for the retrofit programme are now able to be redeveloped on a 3:1 basis enabling us to meet both supply and renewal objectives.
- the impact of COVID-19 on our supply programme and in particular the need to prioritise our supply delivery over the next few years to meet our delivery commitments (and therefore the need for us to consider where the retrofit component of the renewal programme should be focussed in the interim to support rehousing needs associated with our supply programme)
- the ongoing development of functional strategies (e.g. asset management and urban development strategies) that will inform our renewal approach.

Māori build partner engaged for six new homes in Kaikohe

Kāinga Ora has engaged Maori-owned construction firm Yakas Construction to build six new state homes in Kaikohe. Yakas, who are Amotai registered, will be constructing the six homes across two separate sites. Partnering with Māori is a priority focus area of Building Momentum – our construction plan for future homes, and many positive social outcomes will be attached to this development. Yakas are based in Kerikeri, work closely with iwi and actively support Māori career progression. A number of Māori and Pasifika apprentices will gain experience on these sites. Delivery is due in stages from July 2022.

Tai Aroha residential buildings, Hamilton

Initial community engagement, led by the Department of Corrections, has recently started for the demolition and replacement of buildings in Hamilton currently owned by Corrections and used for the Tai Aroha residential treatment programme for former offenders. Located in the central city, the Tai Aroha site is on land leased from Waikato-Tainui. Kāinga Ora will design and build, and be the future owner of the new buildings, which will be leased to Corrections. Further engagement on design plans is planned from mid-2022. Delivery of the new facility, under the Corrections Housing and Support Services Programme, is expected in late 2023/early 2024.

265 Fenton St (former Boulevard Motel), Rotorua

Progress on the conversion of the former Boulevard Motel in Rotorua for transitional housing has been slower than originally expected, largely due to the impact of lockdown. The first of 80 people who will live at the converted property are now expected to be able to move in early next year, rather than in October as originally planned. This has been due to a number of factors, including having to go through the process of engaging new local contractors as previous ones were in Auckland and unable to travel during lockdown, as well as unexpected developments such as the installation of the fully wired fire alarm system required Council consenting. We are making progress and key work already completed includes site fencing, covering of swimming and spa pools, and painting.
