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1. Updates

Subject to common interest litigation privilege

Stafford v Attorney-General & Ors (CA162/2021 [2022] NZCA 165) – application to seek leave to appeal to Supreme Court

On 7 August 2020 (AH 20 055) and 19 March 2020 (Weekly Report 14) resings of a provided you with information on Stafford v Attorney-General (and others). This judicial evicual to which Kāinga Ora and one of its subsidiaries, Housing New Zealand Limited, are parties, places to a Māori Land Claim in the Nelson region that was subject to a Supreme Court decision in 2017.

The Court of Appeal released its decision in May 2022, endouging the proposal by Kāinga Ora to establish a land protection mechanism for 'sites of special significance' with Mr Stafford.

Mr Stafford has since applied to seek leave to appeal the Court of Appeal's decision in the Supreme Court. Kāinga Ora intends to file submissions with the Supreme Court that state it will abide by any decision of the Supreme Court when it considers of the Supreme Court. We anticipate the Supreme Court will consider this application in August 2022. A further briefing will be provided once the catterney of this application is known.

If the Supreme Court grants the application Mr Stafford has also requested a priority fixture be set to consider the appeal. If granted it is possible the appeal will be considered by the Supreme Court before March 2023.

Kāinga Ora has not received any recuests from the media to comment on this litigation. Any media requests we do receive will be recurred to Crown Law, in the first instance.

One-thousan new homes in Tāmaki

The keys have now been handed over for more than 1,000 new homes in Tāmaki, a milestone celetrated by both Kāinga Ora and the Tāmaki Regeneration Company. The thousandth home was an anordate home completed in May 2022 by NZ Living at Hinaki in the suburb of Point England. This ministone illustrates the shared commitment to working in partnership with Tāmaki Regeneration Company.

In 2016, Tāmaki was identified as a precinct that could significantly accelerate the pace of housing delivery in Auckland. Kāinga Ora acts as the master developer to deliver the land development work in Tāmaki, while Tāmaki Regeneration Company manage the public housing tenancies, and lead the community engagement and regeneration activity. The thousandth home is a result of years of collaboration and strong partnership. We anticipate another 320 homes will be delivered in Tāmaki in the next 12 months.

Research into construction materials and labour issues

Kāinga Ora has commissioned AK Research to undertake research into what construction materials and labour issues our commercial partners face. This research aims to provide evidence and data in order to for us to better understand the issues our partners are experiencing and what impact they may have on Kāinga Ora meeting its delivery targets.

The first qualitative stage has commenced this week with nine key Kāinga Ora commercial partners invited to take part in an interview which will help inform the design of the second quantitative stage of the research. The second stage entails a survey being sent to a wide group of Kāinga Ora's partners (including build partners, developers, professional services, service and material suppliers) which will take place over the couple of weeks following the interviews. The aim is to have the research indings by October 2022.

The research findings will be used to inform decision making around any actions we may be ble to take to address these challenges with the aim of ensuring Kāinga Ora is able to delive the lomes it needs to.

Further updates will be provided as the research progresses and when the findings available. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Development and Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) are aware of the research, and we will also continue to keep them updated on the survey results.

Bader Ventura selected as Beacon Project for Construction Sector Accord

We are proud that Bader Ventura, the first Kāinga Ora development to be built to Passive House standard, has been selected as a Beacon Project by MBIE's Construction Sector Accord. The project case study and a video featuring key Kāinga Ora stat and build partner, Precision Construction, will be published in August via the Accord's channels and till also be promoted on Kāinga Ora channels. Beacon projects are well-aligned with Kāinga Ora and Building Momentum objectives of demonstrating leadership and innovation across the sector, and support the Accord's vision of 'a higher performing construction sector for a better. New Zealand'.

More new public housing in Crakei

Kāinga Ora has comple id another 12 new warm dry homes in Ōrākei, Auckland and customers have begun moving in.

The 1400m² development on Sudeley Street comprises three-storey walk-up apartments containing two and three pedro in units. A notable aspect of the design is the stepped layout of the apartment buildings thich are design conflict with two protected Pohutukawa trees, as well as a large Norfolk pine, which it me of a matching pair in the street and important neighbourhood landmarks.

Sude by St eet is second housing delivery by Kāinga Ora in Orākei during 2022. A 17-home development in Grace Street was completed earlier in March. These developments are the first new public housing Ōrākei for nearly 13 years. Previous deliveries were Ngaio Street in 2009 and Kurahaupo Street in 1990.

A blessing, led by Ngāti Whātua o Ōrākei and attended by members of the Ōrākei Project Advisory Group, was facilitated by the regional engagement and partnerships team.

Our build partner was Dominion Construction.

Wainuiomata Marae Trust Eco-Papakāinga Development

Kāinga Ora is developing a proposal to enable and support a papakāinga development, the Wainuiomata Marae Trust Eco-Papakāinga, by building 12 units ranging from 1-5 bedrooms on the land surrounding the Wainuiomata Marae.

The proposed transaction is a 30 year leasehold arrangement with the Wainuiomata Marae Trust. Kāinga Ora will build and operate the 12 homes for a period of 30 years before transferring the assets to the Wainuiomata Marae Trust as papakāinga community housing.

While approval to lease under the proposed terms was granted by the Māori Land Court on 20 May 2022, there are still a range of internal and external processes we need to work through before timeframes can be publicly confirmed. These include ministerial consultation and Kāinga can approvals for the project brief and the final business case. The transaction is structure to be net present value neutral, and therefore financially sustainable for Kāinga Ora to enterioto, the ugh current cost escalations are challenging this outcome.

Next steps include working collaboratively with key partners to confirm feas pilit, sesign the housing, final partnership terms and work to obtain a grant from Te Puni Kōkiri to help over the upfront costs of in-ground infrastructure.

First Colab series homes for sale at Lakeside

There are now 35 new 3-bedroom affordable homes for sales the Lakeside development at Te Kauwhata. The homes are being built by Mike Greer and are part of the Colab Series, which will see at least 20% of homes built at Lakeside over the 1. xt light years delivered within the price cap of \$650.000.

This includes 29 homes priced at \$650,000, 2 names priced at \$599,000 and two homes priced at \$595,000. These free-standing, freehold is ness will be built to a 6 homestar standard and include off-street parking. To be eligible for Colab Series nomes, buyers must be NZ citizens or permanent residents and intend to own and two is the home for two years. The launch of these homes is being supported by a comprehensive 4-week digital marketing campaign.



Sustaining relationships with our partners


Counties Manukau is our largest operating region with 13,500 public homes. The region manages a busy work programme with Spotless, our maintenance partner for South Auckland.





