Upcoming community drop-in sessions in Nelson, Marlborough and West Coast

Our Nelson, Marlborough and West Coast team is hosting a series of drop-in sessions in October and November to inform the community about proposed housing developments.

The team will hold two sessions in Blenheim followed by sessions in Nelson, Tasman, Hokitika, Westport and Greymouth.

The aim of the sessions is to give residents an overview of the developments proposed for the Nelson, Marlborough and West Coast regions over the coming yea's and to begin an ongoing conversation with the community. It is part of the move to a portf lio-based approach to engagement and new ways of connecting with the community.

We are inviting residents to the sessions via a letter drop, newspaper advertisements and Facebook events. We are also releasing the information that will be discussed at the drop-in sessions to media.

Roskill South completed works

All LEAD Alliance work in Roskil. South is complete, which will enable around 950 new, warm, dry homes. In addition to enabling housing, the team have also completed the Freeland Reserve infrastructure and amenity upg ades, a new Council park, character street, pedestrian walkways and a new signalised intersection. This is a significant milestone, not only for Roskill South, but for the Roskill Development, It is the first Neighbourhood to have all civil and infrastructure works complete in the Large Scale P ojects.

Housing Delivery System completes 59-day construction pilot

The new Kāinga Ora Housing Delivery System (HDS) has built its first fully accessible homes in a record 59 business days with a build partner in Christchurch.

HDS is our new efficient method of public housing delivery, alongside our traditional delivery method and market acquisitions.

The 59-day build completion of the three one-bedroom units in Alpers Place, Hoon Hay, have now overtaken the previous HDS construction record of 68 business days, with a further build time reduction of nine days.

The 59-day construction timeframe covered the entire build (including foundations, civil and houses) and reduces the standard construction time for a similar build down by more than half. The average HDS construction time is currently just over three months.

While the speed of this build is a great achievement; visibility, predictability and a consistent workflow are the key principles that enabled the success of this build timeframe.

We continue to test the HDS for different housing typologies, construction complexities and regional differences to ensure it can deliver robustly at scale.

This efficient and predictable way of working is consistently reducing the time to design and plan homes by 94 percent, from 17 months to six weeks. The testing programme is now ramping up its construction work and is ultimately aiming for a construction target of 65 days for two level homes and below.

The efficiencies to date have been achieved through detailed planning, resourcing and sequencing of tasks alongside our build partner, at the same time ensuring we are not compromising on the same high standards as our other delivery models. Two of the three homes are fully accessible, another first for the HDS, with the third Full Universal Design.

Our customers and their whānau

- 224 customers have been rehoused to date
- 24 customers have vacated and left their Kāinga Ora property
- 29 customers currently in TAS (in the past week we saw one househ Id exit and two households enter)
- 6 customers are living elsewhere
- 12 households are living in our own Emergency Response A commodation and there were no entries or exits last week

Central region

- 359 homes in the region have been assessed as having damage from the cyclone with the majority 341 considered minor damage
- We are aware of:
 - o Wairoa
 - two white placards
 - one yellow placard
 - o Hawke's Bay
 - seven while placards
- We have made 4,053 utb und welfare calls, and referred 312 customer to other agencies for support.
- There were 28 customers that were evacuated, but none required permanent rehousing.
