### 1. Updates

### Whangārei engagement

A community drop in session took place on 21 September 2022 in the subuse of Tikktunga in Whangārei. About 40 local people came along to kōrero with us about upcoming thans for new homes in the area. Kāinga Ora staff were on hand to talk to community members about our plans to bring more than 100 new, warm and dry homes to the area over the next few years. The majority of attendees were supportive of new public homes being built, although some aised concerns about housing density.

The most significant of the projects discussed was Wanaka Street, 155 home development we will be acquiring from Soho Group. It will provide three-level walk up as aments and two level terraced housing of one-to-three bedrooms, alongside a multi-purpose community room, shared green space, a play area and a bike shed. Regional Director Jeff Kurray was also interviewed at the event about Wanaka Street development by a reporter from The Northern Advocate.

### New homes being delivered in Blenheim

Fourteen new two-bedroom homes are due to be completed in Brewer Street, Blenheim, in late October 2022. The redevelopment is the largest in Marlborough to date. It is also believed to be the largest number of homes we have built in the region at any one time in at least two decades. The homes are accessible and close to the central city, schools, kindergartens and a park.

Kāinga Ora worked with Whitney School pupils to come up with a name for a new street, Pahūahi Street, which has been created as part of the redevelopment. The name for the new street, which translates to 'fireworks' in English, gets its inspiration from an annual event called Lights over Marlborough. It was created by Whitney Street School in 1983, and is now a major fireworks event in Marlborough.

### **Energy hardship update**

Kāinga Ora Briefing Note BN 22 041 seeks joint shareholding minister approval (Carse f and the Minister of Finance) to issue an indemnity of up to \$1.06 million to electricity recoiler(C) to trial a capped energy bill for up to 1,200 customers over the next two winters. This been a follows on from:

- 1. BN-21-018 that outlined a proof of concept pilot that will improve go entiment understanding of the energy use of our customers and provide insights about the interpentions and measures that best low income individuals and families to obtain adequate energy services to support their health and wellbeing, and
- 2. a conversation you had with Kāinga Ora in March 2022 when we were asked to continue working with agencies to pursue joint Ministers' approval assue a low risk indemnity and process an amendment to the social security regulations to ensure that the financial support of the capped energy bill product was exempt from the definition of income under the Social Security Act.

For Kāinga Ora to continue with this work and segin the research in winter 2023, we require both yourself and the Minister of Finance to agree the request to issue and indemnity to electricity retailers. You may also wish to forward this knieting onto to the Minister for Social Development following approval to highlight the requirement or amendment to the Social Security Regulations.

Ideally we need the indemnity to be approved by the end of October 2022 to allow sufficient time for a two-stage customer recruitmed process and for the income exemption Cabinet process ahead of final customer recruitment. Approval ater man October may delay the proposed May 2023 start date of the pilot.

We have engaged with the algorant government agencies and their views on this work are outlined in the briefing.




