1. Updates

First Retrofits delivered in the South Island

The first Kāinga Ora Retrofit properties in the South Island have been completed and customers are now returning to their homes. To date, more than 25 houses in Christchurch, Rangiora, Ashburton and Dunedin have been brought up to, or above, new build standards – adding another 50 years of life to the properties.

Alongside our build programme, which is delivering more homes at scale and pace, the Retrofit work stream is part of the wider Kāinga Ora programme to improve our older stock as around 40,000 homes will need upgrading over the next 20 years.

Improvements to make these South Island homes warmer, drier and healthier included full insulation (walls, ceiling and floor), double glazing, improved airtightness, ventilation and new heating. New kitchens and bathrooms were added and the homes were converted to open plan living layout, making them more accessible. The feedback from our returning tenants has been extremely positive.

Māori build partner delivers new state homes in Te Tairawhiti

Iconiq Group, a Māori-owned construction firm who whakapapa to Te Tairawhiti, have now delivered the final of six warm, dry new homes in Kaiti, Gisborne. The six homes, on two sites, were Iconiq Group's first build contract with Kāinga Ora; previously Iconiq had undertaken site works for some of our relocatable houses built at Spring Hill Prison and Massey High School.

Iconiq Group are one of four trade schools/academies under a MOU with Kāinga Ora and are currently constructing an off-site manufactured home in their Gisborne housing factory. This will be relocated to a Kāinga Ora site in Martin Road, Kaiti for enabling works and finishing later this year.

Northcote Development delivers more new homes for Auckland

51 new KiwiBuild and market homes have recently been completed and handed over to new homeowners in Northcote Development, despite the impacts of COVID-19. Universal Homes has completed 24 terraced homes, including 11 KiwiBuild homes (six 2-bedroom homes and five 3-bedroom homes). The Universal homes are also the first terraced typology market and affordable homes to be completed in the development. NZ Living has also completed 27 three-level walk-up homes, including 13 KiwiBuild homes (12 2-bedroom homes and one 3-bedroom home). The completion of NZ Living's 'Awataha' development marks 111 KiwiBuild homes now completed and occupied in Northcote Development to date, from an estimated total of 536 more affordable homes.

Settlements with purchasers were initially impacted by COVID Level-4 lockdown restrictions, however all 51 homes are now settled with homeowners moved in.
