Thank you for your email of 17 February 2022 to Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- 1. How much was budgeted by Housing NZ for the resource consent including hearings of Commissioners as noted above?
- 2. How much has been paid by Housing NZ to date in respect of the resource consent including hearings noted above?
- 3. What others costs are anticipated by Housing NZ in respect of the resource consent and hearings noted above?
- 4. Given that 14 Bristol Street is not to be used as a Corrections facility what will the property now be used for?

Kāinga Ora spent a total of \$83,380 (excluding GST) for the consent process for 14 Bristol Street. Of this, \$18,167 was on-charged to Corrections. We do not anticipate any other costs associated with this. Kāinga Ora did not have a separate budget specifically allocated for the consent process.

Kāinga Ora is still considering its options for the property and no decisions have been made at this stage.
