Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities, dated 10 November 2023, for the following information:

1. How many Kainga Ora properties are there currently in Hamilton and how many are marked to be built?

1.1 How many Kainga Ora properties are there currently in the Waikato region and how many are marked to be built?

2. Where are the current Hamilton Kainga Ora properties located?

3. Where are the Kainga Ora properties that are marked for development in *Hamilton* set to be built?

To protect the privacy of our customers we do not give out specific addresses; however, we have provided area location information in the attached spreadsheets.

Kāinga Ora delivers new homes in the following ways:

- Acquired new new housing delivered by a builder/developer on land not already owned by Kāinga Ora.
- **Redevelopment** new housing delivered by a builder/developer on land already owned by Kāinga Ora either after existing homes are deconstructed, demolished or removed from a site, or on vacant land.
- Acquired existing existing homes bought by Kāinga Ora through a Sale and Purchase agreement.

Kāinga Ora prefers to deliver new homes through our redevelopment programme. This is where we remove older houses on larger sections that are past their best and replace them with newly built, warm and dry homes, that better meet the needs of our customers today. The priority of Kāinga Ora is to house people in need, and buying new builds or buy-ins provides additional homes where need cannot be met through redevelopment.

Kāinga Ora also occasionally leases homes from owners.

Attachment 1 provides information on public homes, which are tenanted through a tenancy agreement, and supported homes (Community Group Housing and Transitional Housing).

Community Group Housing is a service provided by Kāinga Ora where we work with a wide range of organisations that provide residential and non-residential community housing for:

- people who experience mental illness
- people who have physical and intellectual disabilities
- people who abuse substances or have addiction(s)
- people seeking refuge
- families who need emergency housing
- children/youth at risk
- people transitioning from prison back into the wider community
- family support (such as Plunket, Barnados, Tamariki Ora, budgeting).

Transitional housing provides people and families in urgent need of housing with a warm, dry, safe place to live while they receive wraparound support services and are helped to find a more permanent place to live. Each programme provides transitional housing for different periods of time.

The pipeline information as at 30 November 2023, is subject to change as new projects may be added and existing projects may not go ahead or may not go ahead as currently planned.

The pipeline information includes proposals in evaluation (projects being planned or assessed for feasibility) or in progress (projects being procured, contracted or under construction).

Attachment 1 provides:

- the number of homes by Census Area Unit (CAU) in the Hamilton City Territorial Local Authority (TLA)
- the pipeline of homes to be built by CAU in Hamilton
- the number of homes by TLA in the Waikato District
- the pipeline of homes to be built in the Waikato District.

Kāinga Ora owns public homes across every suburb in Hamilton and in most towns of the Waikato. Redevelopment projects underway mean the exact number of homes is continually changing, as some older houses are demolished to make way for new.
