Thank you for your request of 15 January 2024 to Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities, for the following information:

"Can I ask please how many houses Housing New Zealand built between mid 2017 to mid 2020, and mid 2020 to mid 2023 in the following cities:

Lower Hutt Dunedin Palmerston North Napier Hibiscus Coast?"

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982.

I have attached a table which provides a breakdown of the number of homes Kāinga Ora has delivered in Lower Hutt, Dunedin, Palmerston North, Napier, and the Hibiscus Coast, up until the end of the 2023 financial year. We will also purchase existing properties as needed, where appropriate homes become available for sale. The acquisition of existing homes and any leased properties have been excluded as these are not properties built by Kāinga Ora. Land acquisitions have also been excluded.
