



Thank you for your email of 12 March 2019 asking for the following information:

'of HNZ stock in the Waikato Region how many are accessible?'

Generally, Housing New Zealand properties are modified to suit a particular tenant's needs. Housing New Zealand and the Ministry of Health have a Memorandum of Understanding relating to housing modifications to existing properties for people with disabilities. Any requests for disability modifications to houses are determined by the health service providers including DHBs and/or ACC, not Housing New Zealand.

The extent and type of modifications depends on the tenant's disability, which will differ from person to person. Modifications can include accessible parking and entries, ramps, and hand rails.

Housing New Zealand has 337 properties in the territorial authorities in the Waikato that have modifications to accommodate disability needs. The following table shows how many properties have disability modifications. We are unable to show the specific modifications a property has, or whether the modifications are for accessibility.

Note: Some of the above territorial authorities include land that is not in the Waikato region.
